



The Quaboag Hills Community Fund is a flexible financial response to urgent financial need

Applicants must be low to moderate income based on household size. Applicants should apply to other applicable area funds before applying to this fund. A household may only receive assistance once in a 12 month period and the maximum amount of funding that will be awarded is \$500.00. Payments will only be made to the vendor, payments will not be made to the applicant.

Examples of types of assistance include:

- To leave a dangerous living situation
- Car repairs
- To avoid eviction
- Heating costs
- Medical expense
- Legal expenses
- Funeral costs
