3. Discuss Kleinfelder scope of work proposal.

After considerable discussion, Mr. Jenkins will research the following before the decision is made:

- -Phone EPA in respect to the permit
- -Question Kleinfelder in respect to the timing of the study. We take less septage in the winter verses warmer months.
- -Check on the difference in pricing between a comprehensive wastewater plan versus

a scope of services evaluation.

Mr. Jenkins noted that if we were to stop taking septage sewer bills would increase approximately \$200.00 annually whereas borrowing a million dollars for example, would be approximately a \$70.00 per year increase for an upgrade.

Mr. Jenkins notified the Board that the Asst. Superintendent Adam Korabowski will be out for extended periods of time caring for his sick wife. The Board of Selectmen have also been notified.
