The contract with the Water Dept. needs to be addressed once the billing is sorted

out with the Selectmen.

4. Charges for closing reads.

After discussion, it was determined that Mr. Nyberg and Mrs. Lapierre would put together a list of ideas to submit to the Board regarding fees and ways to generate revenue.

5. Facility planning/upgrades.

Mr. Nyberg presented to the Commissioners a scope of service from Kleinfelder in which they would prepare a Wastewater Treatment Facilities Plan in order to comply with North Brookfield's NPDES Permit requirements. After discussion, Mr. Nyberg is to contact Kleinfelder to meet with the Commission (tentatively scheduled for March 25th @ 4 p.m.).

6. Financial Update.

Mr. Nyberg stated that the budget is trending a little ahead. Eric Cardeneas has done a fantastic job manually adjusting the blowers in which we will see the benefits in the electrical budget. We just recently dropped an aeration tank which will also aid in cost savings measures.
