3. Superintendents report

Mr. Nyberg presented the following:

- There were no exceedances, however our quarterly toxicity showed a potential issue with regrowth, a retest is scheduled.
- The 2012 F350 was sent to a local mechanic for evaluation due to a check engine light. A lengthy list of required repairs totaling over \$7,000 was provided to the Town. A discussion of these repairs was had and determined to have the Town Mechanic look at the truck and advise.
- RAS Pump #1 developed a hole in the suction cover. This was repaired by an
 outside company who specializes in epoxy and coatings. The pump is back in
 service. New parts for this were reviewed but a lengthy lead time made the
 repair the better option at this time.

4. Financial Updates:

• Final FY21 numbers were reviewed, budget came in ahead of plan due to unanticipated increased septage revenues.

5. Facility planning updates:

- Aeration tank layout and mixing strategies had been discussed and we are having a call next month to determine the best type of technology to utilize for this facility.
- A Call with the engineers and SCADA developers occurred with the main purpose of determining where SCADA connections would most likely need to exist for equipment and terminals.
