Town-owned Open Space Public Use: Rules and Regulations

These rules do not apply to town-owned property that is in active use and that already have rules in place; such as the Common, Rail Trail and Town Forest Park. These rules may also be modified on a site-by-site basis.

- 1) No cutting or taking of wood, stone or any other materials or resources from Town-owned open space, except by permission of the governing authority.
- 2) No building of structures temporary or permanent. Any such structures shall be removed immediately. In areas where hunting is permitted tree stands may be placed a week before the start of hunting season and must be removed within a week after the conclusion of hunting season.
- 3) No dumping of trash or any other debris including wood, brush, or leaves. No littering. Carry in carry out.
- 4) No alcoholic beverages are to be carried into or consumed on property.
- 5) No overnight camping, campfires or fires of any kind except by permission of the governing authority.
- 6) Access permitted one half hour before sunrise until one half hour after sunset.
- 7) All dogs must be leashed, and any droppings are to be removed from any trail or pathway.
- 8) No furniture, chairs, benches, and the like to be left in such parcels except as authorized by the Select Board or committee responsible for the care of such spaces.
- 9) No unauthorized motor vehicles of any kind.
- 10) It shall be the responsibility of persons wishing to travel on any town owned property to be aware of the limits and boundaries of said property and not intrude onto private property.
