

## Minutes of the Board of Selectmen Meeting

This meeting of the Board of Selectmen was called to order on Tuesday, April 7, 2020 at 6:00PM via ZOOM meeting. Dale Kiley, Jason Petraitis and John Tripp present.

Approval of minutes: Mr. Petraitis moved, and Mr. Tripp seconded, a motion to approve the minutes of 3/31. So voted.

BOH Order: Mr. Kiley wanted to discuss the order by the Board of Health to keep Town employees out of the offices. The Selectmen will get clarification from the Board on how they voted for this order and documentation on their legal control of the employees and building. Mr. Kiley will also be in contact with the Board of Assessors to ensure they can enter the building when necessary.

Taxes: Lisa Taylor, Town Collector, asked the Selectmen if they were planning on postponing certain due dates for bills, many towns have. The Board would have to vote to extend the due date. Mr. Petraitis moved, and Mr. Tripp seconded a motion to extend the deadline for Sewer, Real Estate and Excise tax payments to June 1<sup>st</sup> with no penalties or interest occurring until after that date. So voted.

Ian McElwee asked if the Board would allow Lenard Engineering to start survey work for the West Side Infrastructure Study before the contract is finalized. The Board agreed to allow them to start the project since they won't be doing any type of construction. Lenard wants to take advantage of the season to document before foliage appears.

Mr. Tripp said we will be ordering the benches soon (for the park behind the Town sign), still working on getting the ADA table.

Bates: Samuelson and Nash submitted their quotes for work at Bates Observatory. Mr. Tripp is waiting on one more quote.

Mr. Tripp said he checked in with the Highway Department, they are doing well and maintaining social distancing.

There being no further business, at 6:22PM Mr. Petraitis moved, and Mr. Tripp seconded, a motion to adjourn. So voted.
