Since 2006 the people of North Brookfield and the Friends of the Town House have had a dream: Save the historic Town House. Bring it up to code so that everyone can enter and use it. Make it a vibrant "Center of Everything," once again welcoming people as they gather for programs and performances, proms and graduations, and perhaps, even a bite to eat.

During the past year the Friends have come closer than ever to realizing that dream. Since June is the time for renewal, it is a perfect time to reflect on what we have accomplished this past year and set our sights on the way forward:

- While partnering with area businesses and community organizations, the Friends held the following events
 to raise funds and promote public awareness: Arts in the Park, Know Your School Night, the Fall Family Fun
 Fest, the Bemis Holiday Fundraiser Workshop, and the May Festival, for which the Friends acquired a
 \$1,500 MCC Festival grant.
- UpCycle!, our first ROAR program, was a hit with area residents.
- "Giving Tuesday" and Year End Appeals netted over \$6,000 for Town House restoration.
- Working with SBL, a non-profit consultant, we received over \$22,000 from foundations.
- After a request by the Friends for State aid, Rep. Donnie Berthiaume secured \$50,000 in ARPA funds for North Brookfield to use for restoration of the Town House.
- And, just in, word that the Friends have received a grant of \$35,000 from the Mass Cultural Council. With it we can match any donation made to the Friends of the Town House up to a max of \$35,000.
