

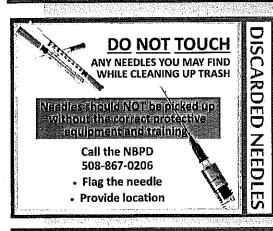

- Wear protective clothing. If needed, protect your skin by
- wear protective conting. In leading, protect your skin by wearing socks, boots, pants, long sleeves and vinyl gloves.

 Wash your skin or your pet's fur. Within 30 minutes after exposure, use soap and water to gently wash off the harmful resh from your skin. Scrub under your fingernails too. This helps prevent a rash. Even washing after an hour or so can help reduce the severity of the rash.
 - Apply a barrier cream. Try over-the-counter skin products that are intended to act as a barrier between your skin and the oily resin that causes poison by rash.

Renel Ticks with DEET or Permethrin

Use repellents that contain 20 to 30% DEET (N, N-diethyl-m-toluandle) on exposed skin and clothing for protection that lasts up to several hours. Parents should apply this product to their children, avoiding hands, eyes, and mouth. Use products that contain permethrin on clothing, boots, and socks.

Find and Remove Ticks from Your Body

Bathe or shower as soon as possible after coming indoors (preferably within two hours) to wash off and more easily find ticks. Parents should check their children for ticks under the arms, in and around the ears, inside the bely button, behind the knees, between the legs, around the waist, and especially in their hair.
