***FY 2024 Town of North Brookfield CDBG Application***

The North Brookfield Board of Selectmen will conduct a Public Hearing on Tuesday, February 27, 2024, at 6:00 PM at the North Brookfield Police Department, 55 School Street, North Brookfield, MA 01535. The public is encouraged to attend this hearing to discuss the Town's FY 2024 application to the Massachusetts Executive Office of Housing & Livable Communities (EOHLC) for up to \$950,000 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds. *If inclement weather occurs, the Public Hearing will be held on March 11, 2024, at 6:00 PM at the North Brookfield Police Department.*

The Town seeks public input on potential grant-funded projects. A potential project under consideration for the application currently includes Phase 2 of the Mount Pleasant Street Improvements Project.

All persons and organizations with questions or comments regarding the grant application will have an opportunity to be heard. If awarded, the Town of North Brookfield will be responsible for administration of the grant program with assistance from the Central Massachusetts Regional Planning Commission (CMRPC).
