3. Superintendents report

Mr. Nyberg presented the following:

- The initial robtic camera work is done, there will be some areas of town that were not able to be inspected due to pipe size or some type of obstruction that will need further investigation. The footage will take about a month or so to come back for our review, once that is complete we can determine best paths forward.
- While the camera work was happening we also were able to enter into an agreement to have all of the manholes marked with GIS coordinates, this will be added to the new database we are working on with our Asset Management system.
- Mr. Nyberg asked if there were any questions about the part time operator job description presented last month. No questions were had about the job description but there were concerns that we may not find a candidate with todays job market. A brief discussion around current times and a decision to move forward with advertising.
- Mr Nyberg presented an energy savings project in regards to the Warren st pump station. There was a discussion on its overall costs vs benefits at the station and for the system. After the discussion the board determined that

adding it to next years budget was appropriate and asked Mr. Nyberg to see if this was possible. He stated that he already had asked, and yes because we can transfer the funds from retained earnings we can do it as part of the overall budget. MR. Nyberg will update the Board of Selectmens office and other associated offices with the new budget numbers.
