


Summary


North Brookfield residents were more random on answers regarding a reasonable time frame with 3 and 5 years to be favorites. Many residents are concerned about the recent downturn in the U.S. and World economy. Reasonable cost seems to swing towards the \$3 Million marker.

According to the survey, attendance for a town wide meeting to support the any decision was high at 558, while only 247 said they could not attend due to schedules and lack of time. Finally, volunteering for such a Renovation Committee was lopsided, with the NO category winning out at 651 to 141. Quite often in most communities this is usually the trend.




Question 1. Are you in favor of renovating the Town House?




Question 2. Are you in favor of demolishing the existing Town House?

Question 3. Are you in favor of a new Town House?






Question 4. What is a reasonable time frame?
